STATEMENT OF CLAIM

- 1. The Plaintiff are the citizens of Ukraine and are engaged in a war with Russia
- 2. The Defendant is the signatory of the The Universal Declaration of Human Rights and has been engaged in activities that are in Violation of Article 10, Article 21 and Article 25.
- 3. The present government has waged a war against Ukraine and have presented a real threat as to the start of world war 3. The invasion has resulted in loss of human life and damage to property both punishable under law.

- 4. The Defendant has not mitigated the situation even after several peace talks and economic sanctions by several UN signatories.
- 5. The Defendant has forced the Plaintiff to inhumane conditions, in constant fear for their health and safety, I on behalf of the Plaintiff propose that all UN signatories enforce total economic sanction equivalent to Gandhi's Non Co-operation movement against the East India Company.
- 6. The Plaintiff urges the Security council to intervene and secure their human rights, using sanctions or such other relief as is deemed just.
